PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Please read installation instructions below. All plumbing should be installed in accordance with applicable building codes and regulations.

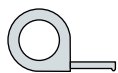
Unpack and inspect the items for any shipping damages. If you find damages, do not install.

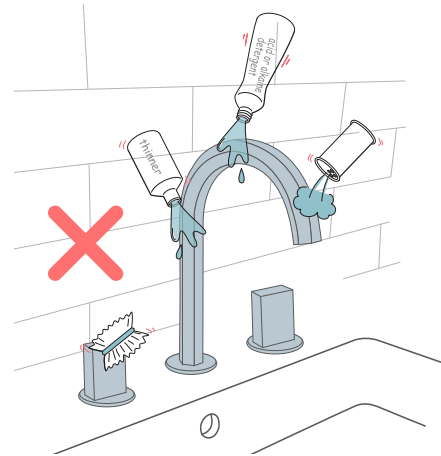
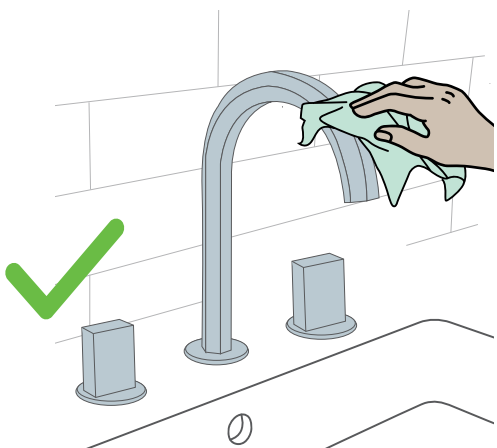
1. Remove the mounting nut, metal washer, and rubber washer from the threaded pipe. Fit the O-ring into the groove of the faucet body. Screw waterlines into the corresponding screw-hole of the faucet body.

2. Insert waterlines and threaded pipe into the hole of the sink. Install rubber washer, metal washer, and mounting nut back to the threaded pipe. Adjust the faucet body correctly and secure with mounting screws tightly.

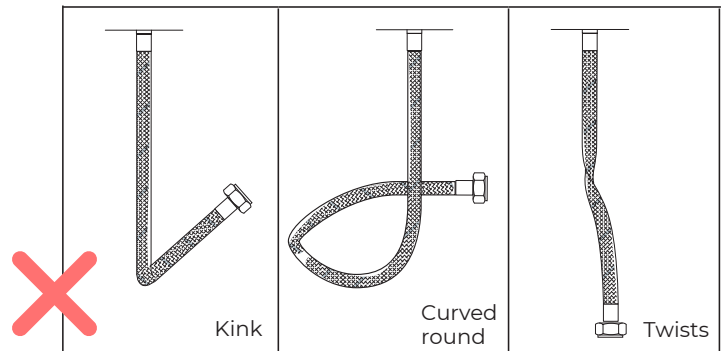
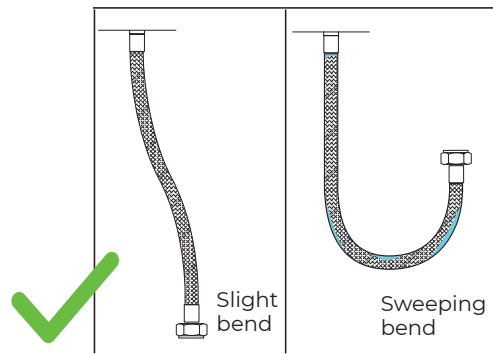
1. Ensure that the water supply below your sink is completely shut off by turning the valve all the way to the right.
2. Remove the T-connector from the spout. first remove the nut that is holding it in place. Set the parts aside.
3. Mark the position on deck where u want to install the faucet.
4. Install Rubber washer on faucet. Ensure that the rubber o-ring is seated properly, and that the nut is tightened firmly using an adjustable wrench.
5. Mark the position of handle and install.
6. Install pipeline. Connect the water pipe line in their connections (Hot & cold).
7. Connect the pipes to T-connector. Use the braided water lines to connect the hot and cold valve stems to the T-connector. While holding in place, hand tighten the lock nut. Finish tightening using a basin wrench.
8. Use an adjustable wrench to tighten, but be careful not to overtighten. Apply thread sealant or plumber's tape to each threaded connection before attaching.
9. Connect the main water supply lines to the valve stems. Apply plumber's tape or thread sealant to the threads before tightening.
10. Turn the faucet on and allow the water to flow for approximately 60 seconds. Ensure that there are no leaks, and that both hot and cold water are running properly.

Care & Cleaning

1. The product can be cleaned with warm water, a mild soap and a clean soft cloth.
2. Clean progressively and gently.
3. It is not required to use any abrasive cleaning pads, wire wool or micro-fibre cloths to clean the product.
4. Avoid a vigorous cleaning action, as this could contribute to denaturing and dulling the finish.
5. Abrasive or strong cleaning products containing ammonia, bleaches, alcohol, dyes, acids (hydrochloric, formic, phosphorus, chlorine or acetic) will be detrimental to the product finish.
6. If using a spray cleaner, apply the cleaning agent onto a soft cloth, never directly spray onto the product as the cleaner may enter gaps and openings and cause damage. Do not allow the cleaner to remain on the product for a period of time. After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clean water.



Flexible Connecting Hose



Care must be taken when connecting the flexible connection hose from the power supply box to the spout to ensure it does not bend sharply and kink or twist. See above for recommended ways to fit the flexible connecting hose.

Important: Failure to follow these guidelines may result in poor performance and damage to the flexible connection hose.
